Affirm Process (Affirm Team)
UCoL is currently exploring the possibility of becoming an Affirming Church. One of the official steps required to become an Affirming church is to update our Vision/Mission & Core/Guiding Principles.

<ul> <li><u>For Congregational Information</u>: In compliance with another step to becoming an Affirming Church, the UCoL Board will update the Marriage Policy language to be inclusive. (Generally, policies are established through Board Approval, and do not require congregational vote.)</li> </ul>
The existing UCoL Marriage Policy is extensive, welcoming and appropriate. In light of the Affirming process, minimal changes in wording will be done to add inclusiveness to the adjectives describing the policy. Less than 10 changes will be made over a multi-page document to allow for the inclusion of all genders and families in marriages performed by UCoL ministry staff. The Affirm Team will submit these minor changes to the Marriage Policy to the March board meeting for approval.
